banners held high*

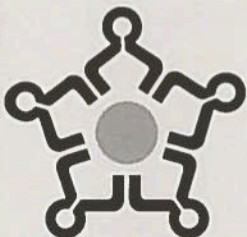
*words illuminating our paths, our lives, dreams and soon-to-be
